

Alachua County Transmittal of Notice Publications 2010

The 2009 legislative session imposed limits on the Clerk's court-related functions to those expressly authorized by law or court rule. In the course of reviewing functions performed by the Clerk's Office, the Clerk has determined there is no authority for the Clerk's Office to coordinate, send to newspapers, track, and account for notices required to be published by parties in a court case.

Effective April 1, 2010, the clerk's office will no longer send notices for publication to the various newspapers on behalf of parties. Rather a party who needs a notice published will be responsible for getting that notice to the appropriate newspaper. To expedite publication, the Clerk will email issued notices to a requesting party so that it can be sent, tracked, and accounted for by the party to the selected newspaper.

This policy will apply to the publication of all types of notices in all types of cases. Additional information regarding publication in foreclosure cases will be posted on the Clerk's web site at www.alachuaclerk.org. The foreclosure information sheet provides contact information for all of the Alachua County newspapers that publish such notices.
